


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Why This Project?

- Addresses largest systemwide bottleneck that we have on MAX
- Adds substantial new service on West side
- Improves service reliability systemwide
- Leverages up to \$100M in federal funds
- Allows MAX service to grow in the future
- Part of a larger set of initiatives to improve reliability and to speed up MAX for all lines and all customers

Project Elements





Project Goals

- 1. Extend Red Line west of Beaverton Transit Center
 - Provide more service to Hillsboro (Fairplex) and Beaverton
 - Fulfill community desires for direct connection to Airport
- 2. Allows MAX system to operate **reliably** and reduce travel times
 - Removes system wide scheduling constraint resulting from single track segments
 - Allow TriMet to increase service in the future
 - Allows for more flexibility in scheduling and other system connections

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Project Resolutions

- TriMet Board Members are asked to consider two resolutions:
 - 1) Adopting the Locally Preferred Alternative
 - Authorizing TriMet to enter into an IGA with the Port of Portland that commits TriMet funding to the project



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
